Wednesday, Feb. 22

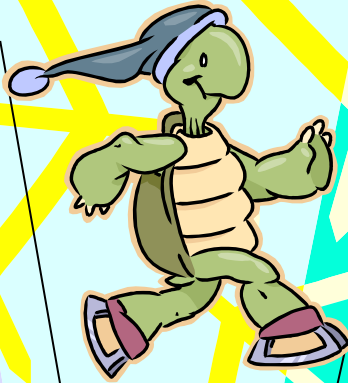
Exciting Explorers
