Payment in full for the first week of enrollment is required as well as a non-refundable deposit of 50% for each additional week reserved.

The weekly balance payment is due the week prior to enrollment. Registrations are processed on a first-come, first-served basis.

**COST**

Girls Incorporated is a licensed child care program and accepts child care vouchers. For private pay families, payments are individualized to family size and need.

**Space is limited!!!** Available space is filled on a first come first serve basis.

To ensure your child's summer, choose the weeks you would like her to attend: pay the first week's fee in full and a **non-refundable** deposit of 50% of your weekly fee for each additional week you wish to reserve. To maintain your child's place in the program, all fees must be settled with the business office the week *preceding* the week of attendance. Late payment may jeopardize your child's enrollment; full payment is expected for all weeks reserved.

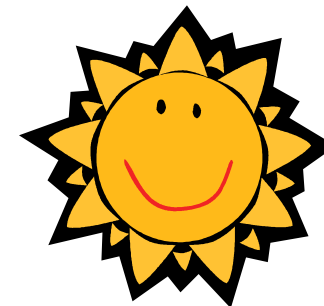
